

If you provided a Letter of Intent to apply for CoC funding in the 2016 NOFA, that was due to Lori Sutton on July 15. Lori cannot accept any applications from agencies that did not provide her a letter of intent. The application was made available July 25 in esnaps. We realize this is a short turnaround time since applications are due to Lori August 7 with supporting documentation. We have been checking daily on the status of the applications in esnaps and although a HUD notice states they were made available July 22, when we actually went into esnaps to find them, only the CoC application portion was in esnaps. It was late in the day on July 25 when the project application was made available.

Yesterday we posted the CoC's Policy and Procedures for project application rankings and the matrix used for new applications to the CoC's website.
