Hello All –

The following members of the Research & Evaluation Committee gathered on June 22 to review the funding requests for Phase 34 of the Emergency Food & Shelter program: Mary Muehlenfeld, Chris Bruns, Cindy Brink, Karen Walker, Jennifer Vancil and Emily Robbearts.

We reviewed requests from the following agencies, which all met the requirements for application:

- Salvation Army
- Community for Christ Assistance Center
- Quincy Catholic Charities
- Horizons Social Services
- Western IL Regional Council
- Two Rivers Regional Council

Attached is our recommendation for allocation of the Phase 34 funds. This recommendation was based on our previously reported funding priorities while also taking into the account the most efficient and effective use of resources required to process the EFSP grant funds.

- The recommendation includes actual dollar amounts for Adams County because that total award has been announced.
- The recommendation includes percentages of the award for Brown, Hancock and Pike counties as their dollar amounts have not been released. We based the percentages on past history of the county award. Should the actual amount be significantly different, we will regroup and discuss the need for reallocation.
