- a. New temporary emergency shelter at 948 North Main in Jacksonville
- b. Can accommodate 6 women, 10 men, and 1 family with children
- c. Completely volunteer run. Alan Bradish serves as Program Coordinator
- d. Process of entry:
 - i. Clients should get a meal at Spirit of Faith Soup Kitchen
 - ii. Go to the Jacksonville Police Station for a clearance check (check for outstanding warrants)
 - iii. Bring the clearance check form to TEOSA for entry
- e. Homeward Bound Program: Jacksonville's Homeward Bound Program provides transportation funding for folks experiencing homelessness who would like to return to a place outside Jacksonville where they could be stably housed.
